ORDER

The Syndicate at its meeting held on 31.05.2014 considered along with recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Syndicate on Examination matters regarding the proposal on amendment to Rule C of the existing malpractice rules and resolved vide item No. 611.10 to amend Rule 'C' of the existing malpractice rules as follows.

Rule C (i) & C (ii) - ₹10,000/- + cancellation of the subjects + **one** chance debarring
Rule C (iii) - ₹10,000/- + cancellation of the subjects + **two** chance debarring
Rule C (iv) - ₹10,000/- + cancellation of the subjects + **three** chance debarring

Orders are issued communicating the resolution of the Syndicate.

The U.O cited at 2.above stands modified to this extent.

The malpractice rules incorporating the modifications as per the resolution of the Syndicate is appended.
